



Romeo Community Schools - Food Service Department will provide an opportunity for families to pick up **FREE** bagged breakfast and lunch meals in a **Drive-Thru or Mobile Walk-Up Meal Service** for all children 18 and under regardless of what school they attend, or whether they qualify for free or reduced meals. No paperwork or student ID required. This free food program is available to ANY child; it is not limited to Romeo Community School's students. *This program will be solely for the pickup of meals, and meals will not be consumed on-site. We encourage families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19 by not congregating at the site and utilizing social distancing once meals have been distributed. *Meal packages will have 2 or 3 day supplies*

Pickup will only be during the week but we will also provide food for the weekend days on Fridays. This is a special program to support ALL kids at a challenging time for all families.
